## Motorcycle Riding Personalities:

Isn't it fun when you ride with a group of MC riders that exhibit totally unique personalities which coalesce and actually make the ride more interesting. Or NOT!

In a recent article in the February 2016 edition of Motorcycle Consumer News, written by Fred Rau under his monthly column captioned as the "Contact Patch", he examines the various personality types who seem to appear on all our rides and which we may be all too familiar with.

The following is a listing of the common types of riders which show up to day rides and other extended trips:
